

Study and Exam Program

To Prove Enrolment Skills For The Professions of Painter – Fine Arts, Painter – Applied Arts, Designer, Photographer, Polygraphist, Librarian, Computer Cartoonist, Computer Designer, Graphic Designer, Luthier After 7th Grade and For the Professions of Jeweller, Mason, Wood Carver, and Ceramist in the Schools of Arts After 8th Grade

1. Drawing a group of volumetric objects from nature. The performance is with black material according to the applicant's choice. The measure of the canvas is 35/50 cm. Duration - 6 (six) academic hours. Held for all applicants after 7th Grade for the professions of Painter – Fine Arts, Painter – Applied Arts, Designer, Photographer, Polygraphist, Librarian, Computer Cartoonist, Computer Designer, Graphic Designer, Luthier and after 8th Grade and for the professions of Jeweller, Mason, Wood Carver, and Ceramist.
2. Painting still life consisted of a group of three objects and two sorts of drapery. The performance is in colours according to the applicant's choice. The measure of the canvas: 35/50 cm. Duration – 6 academic hours. Held for the professions of Painter – Fine Arts and Designer in National Art High School “Tsanko Lavrenov” – Plovdiv, National School of Arts “V. Stoyanov” – Rousse, National School of Arts “Panayot Pipkov” – Pleven and National High School for Theater And Visual Arts – Plovdiv.
3. Creative Drill
 - Figure composition on a given topic. A panel of judges appointed via an ordinance by the director of the respective school seals the topics in envelopes and on the day of the exam two of those get drawn. The applicant works on one of the topics per choice. Performance with black or colour material according to the applicant's choice or with clay – plastics or relief. The measure of the canvas – 35/50, the measure of the plastics – up to 30 cm. Duration – 5 academic hours. Held for the professions of Painter – Fine Arts in National School of Fine Arts “Ilya Petrov”, National School of Arts “Dobri Hristov” – Varna, National High School of Plastic Arts and Design “Professor Dechko Uzunov” – Kazanlak.
 - Decorative composition in colours on a given topic. A panel of judges appointed via an ordinance by the director of the respective school seals the topics in envelopes. One of them is drawn on the day of the exam. Material – tempera paint. The measure of the canvas – 35/50 cm. Duration – 5 academic hours. Held for the profession Designer at National High School of Plastic Arts and Design “Professor Dechko Uzunov” – Kazanlak.
4. Music – Held for the Profession Luthier. The exam is consisted of exercises to check the music abilities which include:
 - singing of a music excerpt as per the applicant's choice;
 - Reproduction of small melody structures and short music phrases set by the panel of judges.
 - Reproduction of meter-rhythmic structures set by the panel of judges.
5. Bulgarian Language and Literature. Held for the Profession Polygraphist in National Professional High School of Polygraphy and Photography (NPHSPP) – Sofia and for the Profession Librarian in NPHSPP and National High School of Ancient Languages and Culture – Sofia. The exam includes a validation of the applicants' editing skills on an unknown excerpt of text. Duration: 4 astronomic hours.

NB:

All examining topics and exercises, as well as the criteria for assessment of the applicants are set by commissions which have been appointed with a ordinance issued by the director of the respective school. The Director of the respective school sets with a ordinance the dates and the specific procedures of the exams held. Entry exams are held only for professions and programs for which an established state plan for entry in the respective school is available. All entry exams are anonymous except for the music exam. Paper and clay are ensured by the respective school. One academic hour is with duration of 45 minutes.
